

## **3300-P010: Web Domain Naming Policy**

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to provide a consistent naming convention for all new state agency and department web sites and web applications being deployed within the State of Wyoming.

### **Scope**

This policy applies to all web sites and web applications of Executive Branch agencies, boards, and commissions (collectively referred to as “agency” or “agencies”).

### **Policy**

1. All new state agency internet and intranet web sites must use one of the following suffixes:
  - Wy.gov (e.g. dot.wy.gov)
  - Wyoming.gov (e.g. doe.wyoming.gov)
  - Wyoming.us (e.g. dfs.wyoming.us)
  - state.wy.us (e.g. gf.state.wy.us)
  
2. The suffixes below are acceptable for public state agency web sites but will not be supported in the state’s primary Domain Name Server (DNS). It is the responsibility of the state agency to either manage their own DNS to support these suffixes, or have the domain names supported outside the state’s DNS server.
  - .edu
  - .org
  
3. A site developed and hosted outside the State of Wyoming infrastructure can be moved into the State Of Wyoming infrastructure using a supported domain name suffix.
